Remember all library sites have 24/7 access with your Trust ID badge and library counters are staffed 9am-5pm Monday to Friday.

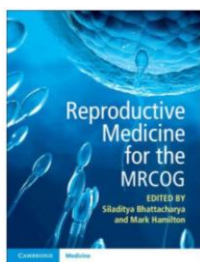
