Remember all library sites have 24/7 access with your Trust ID badge and library counters are staffed 9am-5pm Monday to Friday.


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1. New this month

Managing The Menopause



Mosby's drug guide for nursing students



How to deliver integrated care : a guidebook for managers



Essential guide to acute care



Plastic surgery : principles and practice






Help! I work with people : getting good at influence, leadership, and people skills
